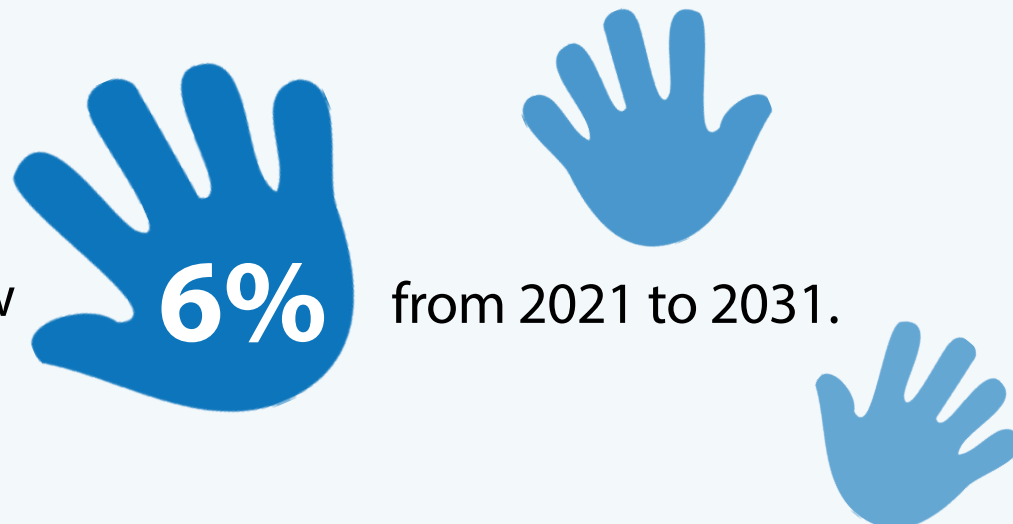


CHILDCARE CAREERS

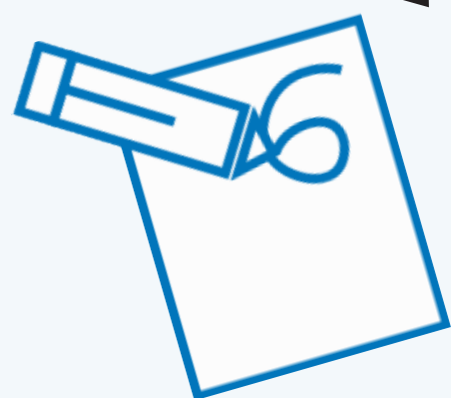

Pediatric Speech Pathologist⁹

Pediatric speech pathologists treat kids who experience communication issues that affect cognitive communication abilities, swallowing, and speech. It is not uncommon for children to experience speech impediments, like stuttering, lisping, muteness, or delay. Pediatric speech-language pathologists, or SLPs, are trained and experienced in treating precisely these kinds of speech and communication problems in children.
