Simulated child care environment in an infant room

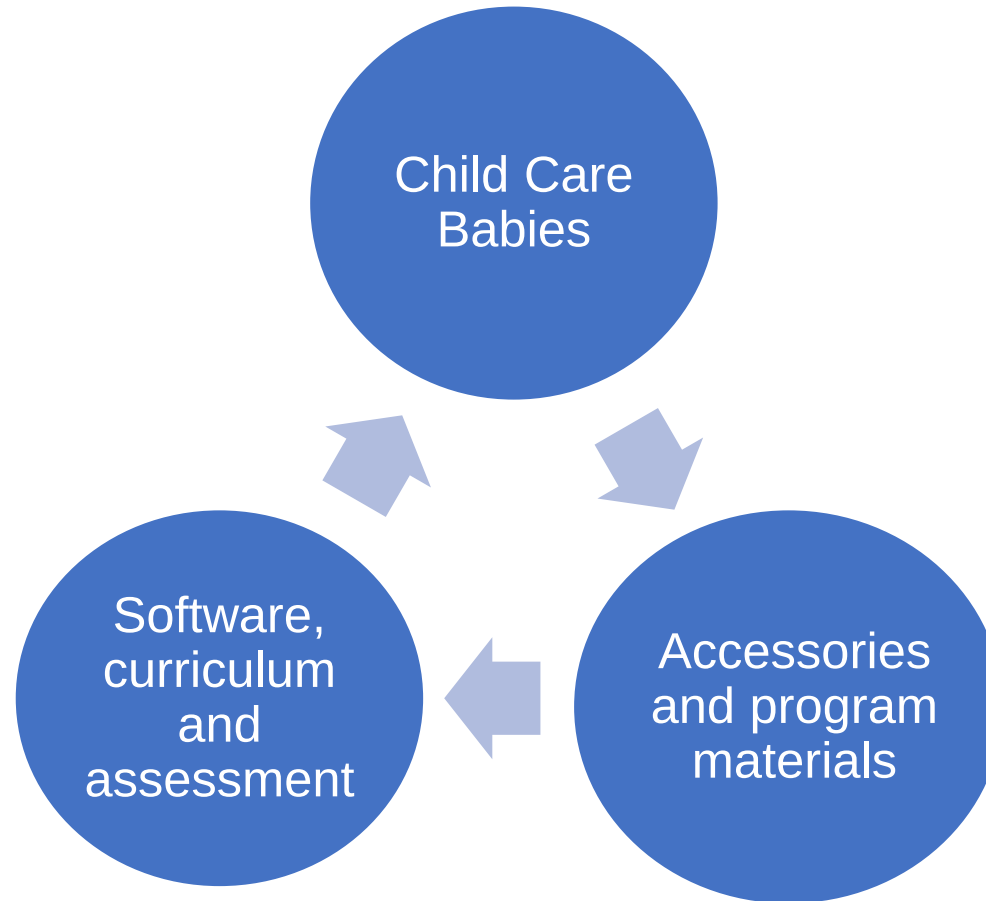
Child care workers care for multiple infants of varying ages simultaneously
